Evangelism Tips

*Sharing your faith with someone might seem intimidating but it doesn't have to be.
Here are a few things to keep in mind as you join Jesus on mission!*

1. You've got what it takes.

- If you are a Christian, you are filled with the Holy Spirit. God dwells in you and wants to flow through you. You don't need to be a powerful communicator or have a theological degree. You know the gospel, you have a story, and God has filled you with His Spirit!

2. God has gone before you.

- Whenever you share the gospel, you can rest assured that God has been at work in their life long before your conversation. Even right now, He is at work softening hearts, opening eyes, and preparing people to hear and respond to the gospel. It's not your job to do the work, you just get the privilege of joining in God's work by sharing the good news and pointing them to Jesus.

3. Listen well.

- Get to know people. Listen to the things they're passionate about. Learn what matters most to them. Find out about their hurts and their experiences of brokenness. Listening well and genuinely caring for a person will help you naturally make gospel connections.

4. Share your story.

- Every Christian has a story to tell. Write out your story so you know how you would share it with someone to highlight the gospel and point to Jesus. Your story includes:
 - Your life before Christ
 - How you came to know Christ
 - Your life since coming to Christ

5. Keep the conversation going.

- Jesus commissioned us to make disciples and that takes time. A person may or may not trust in Jesus after you share the gospel with them for the first time, but either way, that shouldn't be the last time you talk with them about the gospel. Look for opportunities in the days and weeks ahead to follow up on the conversation. See if they've thought about it anymore and continue to share about God's work in your life and what He is doing in and around you.

6. Trust God with the results.

- You can't make someone believe the gospel. Focus on faithfulness. Be diligent to see and seize the opportunities God puts before you to point others to Him and then trust Him to use that for His glory. Invite them to turn from sin and trust in Jesus, and then let God do the heart work needed for new birth.
